

RESUS4KIDS – Basic Life Support for Allied Healthcare Rescuers **EQUIPMENT REQUIRED**

Room (1 room per instructor to run the scenarios separately, communication and teamwork can be run in a larger group)

Manikins

- Choice of Resusci Baby First Aid or Resusci Baby QCPR with Skill Guide or ALS Laerdal Infant manikin
- Little Anne adult torso

Other Equipment

- Laerdal adult pocket masks (to be cleaned at the end of each session) (1 mask per participant)
- 6 tennis balls
- Computer and projector – ensure sound volume is adequate beforehand.
- Access to MET Call in Focus videos and the Paediatric Anaphylaxis Videos– suggest download before hand
- Attendance Record Sheet
- Sheet of blank labels for names of participants

Disposable Equipment – lungs to be changed on all manikins used at the end of each session

Note: The Resusci Baby QCPR and Skill Guide provides instant feedback to participants about the compression depth and rate as well as the effectiveness of the breaths being administered to the infant manikin. This is an option for the course and is not essential. The Resusci Baby first aid or the ALS Infant is the manikin required for this program as it allows participants to perform chin lifts and jaw thrusts on the manikin and compressions are more realistic than compared to baby Anne.

Cleaning

A cleaning solution can be purchased from Laerdal to clean the manikin faces between each session. Please refer to the manufacturer's instructions for cleaning of the pocket masks.
