



Managing Emergencies in Paediatric Anaesthesia (MEPA) for consultants

Course Overview:

MEPA is designed to provide a comprehensive update in paediatric anaesthesia and resuscitation. Participants will develop management strategies for dealing with emergencies in paediatric anaesthesia. The course is a one-day interactive program utilising medium and high fidelity simulation and using expert peer-reviewed scenarios. Develop and demonstrate effective management of common and serious emergencies in paediatric anaesthesia.
Develop skills in effective team leadership, team work and communication during emergencies.
